

New Plant Brings State of the Art Technology Here

The new M-G Feed Mill has 43,000 square feet, or the equivalent of an acre of land

under roof.

The mill tower, which is concrete and 140 feet high, is

where almost all ingredient storage is located.

Also, most of the machinery

that makes the feed is located on different levels in the tower.

While the tower is 140 feet high there are elevator legs reaching as high as 220 feet.

The mill is capable of producing a hefty 90,000 pounds of mixed feed per hour.

The ingredient bins hold approximately 7.5 million pounds of bulk material.

With the mill tower being concrete it should last for many years.

"With the type of machinery that we have installed in the mill

our finished product will be second to none," said Mark Kloesel, company president.

"We have built a reputation in the feed business as having the best service of all our competitors.

"With the new mill our service will only get better plus the quality of the feed will be excellent," he said.

The M-G Feed Division currently employs approximately 50 employees and Kloesel said the company is looking for future growth and the possibility of adding more employees.

"The feed mill has been in the planning stage for over two years and we believe there are none better," he said.

"Technology has come a long way in the feed milling industry and we will be using the latest that pertains to our business," the M-G President noted.
