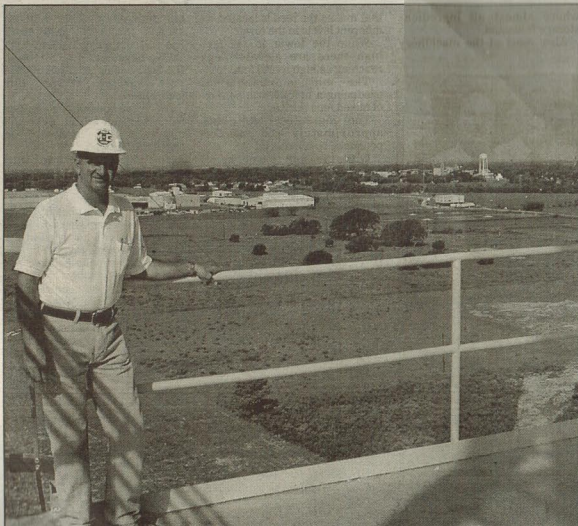


Mark Kloesel Leads M-G Inc. into 21st Century

The president and chief executive officer of M-G Inc. is Mark Kloesel.

He has served as president of the company since 1989 and during that time has overseen continued expansion and change in the business.

Kloesel was born and raised in Weimar and is a graduate of Weimar High School.

He attended Wharton Junior College and Sam Houston State University. He graduated from Sam Houston State University in 1975.

Kloesel began working for M-G Farm Service Center at the age of 16 while he was still in high school. He later also worked at the Egg Division.

After graduating from college, he moved back to Weimar and continued working at the Egg Division. In 1978, he transferred to the feed mill.

He was named president of M-G Inc. in 1989.

During his tenure as president, the firm has shown continued growth entering the farm implement business in 1994 when it acquired Loessin Implement.

The new \$6 million feed mill is the latest milestone in the company's growth.

Under Kloesel's leadership, the company has continued to be a strong supporter of local, community and charitable organizations.

Kloesel has also been active in civic and community affairs.

He has been a member of the Weimar Lions Club.

In addition, he and his family are members of St. Michael Catholic Church and he has served on the St. Michael School Board.

Currently, he is serving his second term on the Weimar School District Board of Trustees.

He has coached Little League baseball and softball for the past 15 years and has coached basketball at St. Michael School.

During that time he has served as Little League president and a director of the organization.

Kloesel is also a member of the Weimar Zoning Commission, the Weimar Development Foundation and Weimar Chamber of Commerce.

He is also a member of the board of directors of Hill Bank & Trust Co.

Kloesel and his wife, Shannon, have two children: a son, Rex, who also works for M-G, and daughter, Jill, who is a sophomore at Weimar High School.
